Know Your Choices

Stay with Traditional Medicare

If you decide on traditional Medicare (Medicare Parts A and B), you can:

1. Add a Medicare Part D plan to cover your prescriptions.
2. Choose a Medigap plan to fill the “gaps” in traditional Medicare, such as co-payments/coinsurance and deductibles.

OR

Use Medicare Advantage

Medicare Advantage provides all the coverage traditional Medicare does and usually includes prescription drug coverage. A Medicare Advantage plan may offer other benefits, too, such as vision, dental and more.

Once You've Decided on a Path, Think About What's Important To You

Once you've decided which path to take, it's time to choose a Medicare plan. *Allsup Medicare Advisor* knows that not all plans are created equal. So, when reviewing your Medicare plan choices, you'll need to consider:

1. Whether portability is important to you. In other words, if you travel frequently, you may need to use your coverage outside the area where you live. If you don't travel, portability may not be an issue.
2. Whether you are willing to see other doctors—if your doctors are not in a plan(s) network.
3. Whether your prescriptions are covered by the plan(s) you're interested in joining.
